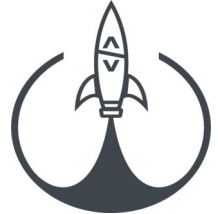

Smart Car Developers

Smart Car Developers is a STEM Education program where students transform LEGO EV3 robots into self-driving cars using visual coding techniques. Teams compete in two challenges:

- Smart Car Challenge: Students will program their Cars to navigate through an obstacle course.
- Smart Car Dance Off: Students will showcase their programming skills by making their smart cars compete in a dance-off.
