

## **Superintendent's Welcome Letter**

Dear South Orange & Maplewood Family,

Please allow me to be among the first to welcome you to the 2019-2020 school year! I am honored and humbled to serve as your Superintendent of Schools. Thank you to our Board of Education for entrusting me with the enormous responsibility of leading our District as the designated Chief School Administrator. I do not take this opportunity/responsibility lightly.

You may be aware that I have had several opportunities to meet with parents and stakeholder groups in the months prior to my official appointment. This summer I have been constantly meeting with (or responding to) stakeholders, both internally and externally on a daily basis; in doing so I am gathering very valuable information that will increase my effectiveness. I am however aware that these previously mentioned meetings represented just a very small percentage of our SOMSD Family. So please allow me to tell you about my beliefs and educational philosophy.

- I am **child-centered**, **research-based** and **data-driven** (in that order).
  - O I constantly remind our educational professionals that all of the work that we do should be able to be backwards mapped directly to how we <u>positively impact our students</u>. We must also be transparent with our students and families regarding the reasoning and logic behind the decisions that we make:
  - I do not believe in 'experimenting' on our students. We should seek
     tried and true methods and materials that have the support of robust
     high-quality research; and,
  - O I am a staunch proponent of keeping a close eye on our progress. This has to be done by comparing our actual data to the goals that were set prior to implementation. This allows us to both avoid surprises in our achievement outcomes and adjust our instructional practices as needed to have the best academic results.
- My educational philosophy is rooted in Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs, that
  in short, surmises that we must first meet (satisfy) our students' needs (i.e.
  physiological, psychological, emotional etc.) before the learner can truly
  realize their highest potential.
- As a servant leader I view removing impediments to our school family's success as a very significant part of my charge.
- I began my official appointment on July 8, 2019. During this transition time I utilized my first few weeks to focus on three (3) priorities:
  - 1. **Learning** the culture, practices, processes and challenges of our District;
  - 2. **Instilling** confidence in stakeholders with regards to my *commitment*, *abilities* (knowledge-base) and *character* (responsiveness, decisiveness and empathy); and,
  - 3. **Verifying** that we are prepared to open the school year successfully.

Part of the process of verifying that we are prepared to open school of course includes the high priority of filling employment vacancies. Human Resources has been working diligently with both our Central Office and School-based Leadership Teams to vet the professionals that can potentially become a vital part of the service that we give our community.

Other high priorities include the deep cleaning of our school buildings, the completing of the master scheduling process for each school, the student registration and residency procedures for new and returning students, the completion of the procurement process for needed goods and services. All of these pieces are critical to providing our community with a successful opening of our school year. I would like to take a moment to recognize all of the members of our SOMSD family who worked long hours this summer to ensure that these vital tasks are completed. Much of what they do is not seen but without their efforts we would not be successful.

In closing, please know that I believe our journey is **collaborative**. It's a true cyclical partnership...Students, Parents, Teachers, Support Staff, School Leaders, and Central Administration etc. We need each other to fulfill the mission of our School District...

"The mission of the South Orange Maplewood School District is to empower and inspire each student to explore and imagine, to pursue personal passions, and to collectively create a better future by creating a learner-centered environment through multiple pathways; reimagined structures, systems and supports; innovative teaching; partnering with families; and maximizing community expertise and resources."

**Together we** can ensure our children thrive as we successfully embrace this mission...but we cannot be successful in silos. This work must be done **together**...listening to **everyone's** voice and contributions toward the collective betterment of our district. **Equity** is non-negotiable...**Progress** is non-negotiable...**Student Achievement** is non-negotiable.

#### STUDENT AND STAFF SAFETY

The safety of our students and staff is always the highest priority for the South Orange Maplewood School District. We coordinate our approach to school safety with the Police and Fire Departments of South Orange and Maplewood. Security procedures are established for all of the schools – schools are locked, unauthorized visitors are prohibited, cameras monitor all who enter our buildings, and each school has a crisis management team. We thoroughly review, evaluate, and update safety practices and security plans on a routine basis.

In addition, we conduct state-mandated emergency drills – both a fire drill, and a security drill – at each school every month. Security drills include non-fire evacuations and lockdown situations. We practice a different security drill each month, repeating them as necessary, to ensure that each security drill is practiced at least twice a year and that students and staff know what to do to protect themselves in various situations. After each safety drill, we closely monitor our students' reactions, and we evaluate our procedures to seamlessly blend these exercises into our standard safety practices.

#### **VISITING SCHOOLS**

When visiting any of our schools, we ask the community to contribute to the overall safety and security of our students and staff by helping in the following ways:

- Visitors must enter the school through the main entrance at any time during the day. While this may be an inconvenience for some visitors, it is an essential component in our efforts to secure District school buildings.
- When buzzing in at the main entrance, you may be asked to announce your name and the purpose for visiting the school to the front office staff. Please be patient if we ask clarifying questions.
- Please do not hold open the door for other visitors. All visitors must be admitted by a staff member.
- Upon admission to the school, all visitors to our Elementary Schools are to report directly to the front office at any time during the day. Visitors to Columbia High School and our Middle Schools should report to the Visitors' Desk. Once there, please sign in, announce your intention, and wait for direction. This procedure does not change after the school day.

We are grateful for the ongoing support and assistance of the entire community in keeping our students and staff safe.

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

Most students live within walking distance of their assigned school, and their parents are expected to ensure their safe transport to and from school each day.

The Board of Education provides round-trip transportation between home and school for South Orange and Maplewood resident students grades K-8 who live more than 2 miles from their assigned school and students grades 9-12 who live more than 2.5 miles from their assigned schools. If the district assigns a student to a school outside of his or her home area to attend the ELL Program at Clinton or the Demonstration Program at Seth Boyden, the student is eligible for bussing if he or she lives more than 1 mile from the assigned school.

Classified special education students may be eligible for transportation according to their IEP. Call the Special Education Department at 973-762-5600  $\times$  1840 for more information.

#### **LUNCH ACCOUNTS**

Studies have proven that children who eat a hearty breakfast and lunch are more focused and peaceful in their studies and social settings. For many children, school lunch is the most important meal of their day. Students are welcome to bring their own lunch from home. SOMSD also offers a full School Lunch Program, and students can purchase a school lunch and/or a la carte food items in the cafeteria.

**Elementary School**: To participate in the lunch program you must open a MyPaymentsPlus lunch account, since cash is not accepted in our elementary program. Elementary students have four options: 1) Deposit money in MyPaymentsPlus lunch account online (plus associated fees); 2) Send a lunch from home; 3) Bring in a check or money order to school to pay for lunch; or 4) Go to Columbia HS to make payments on your child's account (cash is accepted in person).

**Middle & High Schools**: Student share four options: 1) Deposit money in MyPaymentsPlus lunch account (plus associated fees); 2) Send cash to school daily; 3) Bring in a check or money order to school to pay for lunch; or 4) Send a lunch from home.

#### **DELAYED OPENINGS**

Delayed openings are communicated to all SOMSD families and staff via the same channels as emergency closings. All schools start 2 hours later than their usually scheduled start times. If your child usually takes a bus to school, the bus will arrive approximately 2 hours later than the typical pick up time.

#### **MAKE-UP DAYS**

Should the District use more than the THREE allotted emergency closing days, the first Make up Day will be **Friday**, **April 17th**, working *backwards* to **Monday**, **April 13th** as needed or at the end of the school year if emergency closings occur after **April 17th**.

If only TWO emergency school closing days are used, schools will be closed on **Friday**, **May 22**, **2020**.

#### **Family/School Connection**

SOMSD recognizes the vital importance of the home-school partnership, and provides regular updates so that parents and guardians can support their students' development.

#### **Elementary School**

**Elementary School Parent/Teacher conferences** are offered twice a year, in November/December and March. Conferences are a great opportunity to talk one-on-one with your child's teacher about how your child is doing, to ask questions, to share concerns, and to discuss things you may want to work on with your child at home.

Three **report cards** and three **interim reports** go home during the year, and **writing folders** will be sent home at the end of each unit so you can review your child's writing projects, and the teacher's assessment of their work. If you have questions about your child's progress, please talk to your child's teacher – this is the best place to start!

If you feel like your child is struggling or needs extra help, please discuss your concerns with your child's teacher, and ask about the resources available to support students. Your child may qualify for Academic Intervention, the Achieve Tutor Program, or the Elementary Social Work Program. If you have significant concerns, consider discussing the possibility of requesting a referral to the Special Services department.

#### **Secondary School**

**Parent Portal (PowerSchool)** is a powerful tool for monitoring assignment grades and attendance in real time, as well as checking final quarter grades. **Progress reports** are sent home to all middle and high school students just after the mid-point of each marking period, four times per year. Pupils and their parents are encouraged to consult with teachers regarding academic progress.

Formal parent teacher conferences are only held at the elementary school level. At the secondary school level, parents should arrange conferences by making appointments directly with their child's teachers and guidance counselor.

Report cards are issued four times a year for secondary students, and are mailed to the students' homes.

**Arrearages** must be paid before the end of the year. Students are notified of any fines that are levied against them for lost and/or abused books and/or equipment, and are responsible for them. No credentials (final report cards or transcripts) will be issued or examination privileges granted to any student until all arrearages are cleared.


