PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Conduct observations, design data collection instruments, summarize and analyze behavioral data, write functional behavioral assessments (FBA) and develop and maintain behavior intervention plans (BIP).
2. Conference with staff and/or parents concerning individual children's behavior plans.
3. Serve as a resource person to staff and/or parents.
4. Provide ongoing training to staff concerning appropriate use of crisis prevention, behavior management and intervention techniques.
5. When necessary, and in concert with the administration and the classroom teacher, conference with parents concerning specific crisis situations involving their child.
6. Other assigned tasks as determined by the administration.
