You must send an email by July 1 to MrCofCHS@hotmail.com noting in the message "AP Comparative GovPol 2020-2021" merely providing your email address for and receipt of summer communications and acknowledging receipt of these assignments, the course agreement, and the grading rubric for the oil paper- **this is your first homework grade**

Read or watch the news every day and cut out or take notes on the significant reporting directly relating to the Governments, politics, economics, social and cultural events, and legal issues of the six foreign nations that we will be studying: GREAT BRITAIN, NIGERIA, RUSSIA, CHINA, MEXICO and IRAN. Organize the articles or notes by country and bring them to class on the first day of school appropriately secured with your name on the packet. A grade will be given based on the number and suitability of the articles and notes. There will be a current events test the first week of school.

3. Prepare a typed (double-spaced) formal paper as described below TO BE **EMAILED TO ME AT THE ABOVE HOTMAIL ADDRESS BY AUGUST 15.** Please use a word document or PDF, but **not Google Documents**. (late papers will have deductions of credit---failure to do the paper may result in being dropped from the course.

The Report:

Prepare a typed report of no more than 2500 words (include a word count) discussing the impact which OIL has on the political, social and economic dynamics of each of our six foreign countries. See grading rubric below.
