You must send an email by July 1 to MrCofCHS@hotmail.com noting in the message "AP US GovPol 2020-2021" merely providing your email address for and receipt of summer communications and acknowledging receipt of these assignments, the course agreement, and the grading rubric for the impeachment paper- **this is your first homework grade**

2. Read or watch the news every day and pay close attention to the political, economic and legal US news. Take notes if you think it wise as there will be a current events test the first week of school.

3. Prepare a typed (double-spaced) formal paper as described below TO BE **EMAILED TO ME AT THE ABOVE HOTMAIL ADDRESS BY AUGUST 15.** Please use a word document or PDF, but **not Google Documents**. (late papers will have deductions of credit----failure to do the paper may result in being dropped from the course. A quiz on the impeachments will be given the first week of school.

The Paper:

Prepare a typed COMPARISON AND CONTRAST report which summarizes the facts and laws pertinent to the impeachment proceedings of Andrew Johnson, Richard Nixon, Donald Trump and William Clinton which shall conclude with your opinion, supported by the facts and law and your sense of the purposes underlying the impeachment and removal power, as to why each president should or should not have been impeached and/or removed from office. A five page maximum will be enforced on this report. Again, a quiz on the issue of impeachment will be given the first week of school.

IMPORTANT NOTES! EVERYONE IS REQUIRED TO TAKE THE AP TEST IF THEY ENROLL IN THIS COURSE, even if credit is not provided by the college which you decide to attend. DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR, ALL COURSE WORK MUST BE MADE UP BY ABSENTEES WITHIN THREE DAYS,

SO THAT THE WORK CAN BE REVIEWED, IN ORDER TO RECEIVE CREDIT
