Dr. Fergus has published numerous articles and books including **Solving Disproportionality and Achieving Equity** (Corwin Press, 2016). He has worked with over 65 school districts since 2004 on educational equity and school reform. Dr. Fergus is an expert consultant for the U.S. Department of Justice Civil Rights Division on Educational Opportunities (2014-present) and NAACP Legal Defense Fund (2018).*
