**Deadline:**        Registration begins on Monday, December 11 and ends on Monday, December 18

**Two ways to register:**

1. **Register & pay on-line** to ensure your spot and receive immediate class confirmation. Just go to the District website - [www.somds.k12.nj.us](http://www.somds.k12.nj.us). Beyond the Bell is listed under *Site Shortcuts* on the left-hand side of the screen. You can also register through the Seth Boyden Website.
2. **Send in paper registration** and payment by check via student’s backpack in an envelope marked “Beyond the Bell” or bring to school main office. Please make sure if using paper registration, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> choices are filled in.

**Note:** If minimum enrollment requirement is not met for an individual class, we may have to cancel that class.

**Fees:**                All classes are \$95 per class. Payment accepted by credit card on line or check payable to **SOMBOE**. If paying on line, there is a credit card processing fee.

**Scholarships:** Available to those students who receive free or reduced-price lunch. Scholarship students who receive a waiver based upon a ‘Reduced’ meal status will be asked to pay a \$25 fee. If you qualify and would like to request a scholarship, please mark “Scholarship Requested” on the registration form, check off permission to confirm lunch eligibility. Please note that there is a limit of 1 scholarship class per student and that there are a limited number of scholarships per session. If your child received a scholarship in the fall session, he/she is pre-qualified for a scholarship for the winter session. **Scholarship Fund:** If your family would like to fully or partially fund a child to participate in the Beyond the Bell program, please add additional amount when checking out on line or to your check.

## **PROGRAM LOGISTICS**

**YMCA After Care Program at Seth Boyden:** Please make sure to follow the YMCA guidelines for late arrival to the After Care Program if your child is participating in Beyond the Bell Enrichment.

**Dismissal: 4:25 sharp.**

Parents/caregivers should pick up children in the lower gymnasium where they will be required to sign their children out.

If you arrive 10 minutes or more after the end of your class, your child will have been taken to the front hallway to wait with on-site coordinators—please buzz the office using the buzzer located outside the main door and your child will be brought to you to sign him/her out. We recognize that there is an occasional emergency. However, **if you are late two times during a session** your child will be excused from the program. Tuition is non-refundable. Again, please be sure your child is picked up on time.

**Attendance/absences:** Children attending enrichment classes will report to the lower gymnasium on Mondays and Thursdays at 3:15pm for attendance. Their enrichment instructor will pick them up there and take them to their classroom. Classroom teachers will have a list of the students in their class who are attending enrichment classes, but it is a good idea for you to remind your child about enrichment on Monday and/or Thursday mornings.

**If you are not sending your child to his/her enrichment class, call Seth Boyden School at 973-378-5209 and leave a message in the main office.** Please specify the child's name and enrichment class.

**If you are picking up your child early at school,** call the main office and tell the secretary that your child will not be attending enrichment class.

**If we have not been so notified and your child doesn't show up for Enrichment,** we have to assume that the child forgot to go to class and is on his/her way home. We will then institute our emergency procedures, as described on the registration form. Should your child arrive home, call the school IMMEDIATELY and let us know.

**School Closings:** Every effort will be made to re-schedule enrichment classes if there are cancellations due to weather or other unexpected situations resulting in the closing of school facilities. In the event that the day(s) cannot be made up, there will be no refunds.

**Respect:** For the safety and security of all students who participate in the Seth Boyden *Beyond the Bell* After School Enrichment Program we ask parents to please remind your children to be respectful of others and our teaching staff. The staff and teachers work together diligently to help children learn and have fun together in an encouraging and warm learning environment.
