### APPLICATION FOR SENIOR PRIVILEGE, 2017-2018

Seniors who are in good academic standing, and who have a record of having demonstrated good school citizenship and attendance, may apply for a Senior Privilege pass in the third week of school. These students may use their Senior Privilege time:

- *in the library (after signing in) or in any academic lab, or*
- *they may leave campus and return at the end of the period and show their pass to the front security desk staff upon returning to school.*

Students *may not* return to the building with food or beverages in hand. Students with a period 1 or with a period 2 (if not already having a period 1 class) may arrive at the CHS door to enter at the beginning of Period 2 (if their Senior Privilege is during Period 1) or at the bell to begin Period 3 (if their day starts with and Senior Privilege is during Period 2). Students with a Senior Privilege that falls at the end of their academic day may leave at that time. Generally, students must meet a grade requirement of a B or better in all of their classes. Citizenship, attendance and academic standing will be evaluated on a quarterly basis by the CHS administration. Senior Privilege is not guaranteed to all seniors, and as such may be revoked at the discretion of the CHS administration.

***Failure to use the Senior Privilege pass appropriately will result in the loss of the Senior Privilege with a re-assignment to a supervised study hall.*** Seniors will lose the Senior Privilege if they:

- decide to cut a class,
- accrue 3 or more morning lates to school within a marking period,
- commit an act that results in disciplinary act that could result in suspension.
- Engage in behavior otherwise in violation of the CHS or SOMSD Code of Conduct

Students requesting this privilege must obtain parental consent and hand in all necessary paperwork prior to being granted approval. This privilege may be revoked if a student violates any rules set out in the contract. The administration reserves the right to suspend the senior privilege at any point during the school year. Students who are granted Senior Privilege will be notified by a list of student ID numbers outside of the Main Office on or around September 25 and will, at that time, pick up their ID lanyard to be worn during the Senior Privilege period from our front desk security staff. The lanyard must be worn during the Senior Privilege period.
