Please read this packet carefully and follow the directions in it. Failure to meet deadlines or submission of an incomplete packet will render you ineligible for this year's membership in the NHS.

Membership in the CHS chapter of the NHS is open to students who are currently juniors. The induction GPA requirement is a cumulative grade point average of **3.5** earned during freshman and sophomore years.

Please submit all materials required for application to Mr. Maietta, School Counselor, by **3:30 pm on Friday, December 16th**. Be sure to email Mr. Maietta at smaietta@somsd.k12.nj.us with questions or reach him by phone at 973-762-5600 x1039 well in advance of that deadline should you have any questions.

Completed application materials will include:

- Your cover page
- Your personal statements in answer to questions below and information requested in this packet
- Your parent/guardian signed statement of understanding
- Your signed contract

The Faculty Council will review all membership materials in early January. It will make membership decisions before February 1st, 2017. New members are required to begin their community service tutoring during lunch starting on February 20th. Tutoring sessions will be scheduled to coincide with members' lunch periods; no classes will be missed in order to fulfill your tutoring commitments.

PARENT/GUARDIAN AND STUDENT STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING

We understand that membership in the Columbia High School chapter of the National Honor Society is a privilege. We understand that the criteria for membership include student leadership, community service, scholarship, and character in accordance with the national organization.

We understand that completion of the application for membership places a student into consideration for membership. In accordance with the guidelines and charter of the NHS, the Faculty Council decisions are confidential and are final. Students who are not deemed eligible in an academic year in which they apply are welcome to apply in the next school year during the membership period. Applications for membership in the 2017-18 school year will be taken starting in summer 2017.

NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY CONTRACT

As a member of the Columbia High School National Honor Society, you must fulfill the following requirements:

1. Complete a minimum of 20 hours of NHS-based service mentoring/tutoring per semester.
2. Attend the induction for new members in February 2017 at CHS.
3. Attend NHS meetings (one per month).
4. Maintain a 3.5 unweighted or 4.1 weighted cumulative GPA.
5. Submit \$10 annual dues within 30 days of the induction ceremony. Financial need will not impact your eligibility to be a member of the NHS at Columbia. Please indicate any need for financial assistance for NHS membership to Mr. Maietta.

In accordance with our charter agreement with the National Honor Society, your membership in the Columbia High School chapter of the National Honor Society *may be revoked* by the Faculty Council of the chapter, in agreement with CHS administrators, in the event of

- failure to meet the above-listed requirements *and/or*
- conduct demonstrated by you that comprises one or more of the four values of the National Honor Society (as indicated in the guidelines of the national organization) *and/or*
- conduct by you that is grounds for disciplinary action, suspension or expulsion from CHS.

By signing this contract and participating in the induction ceremony of the National Honor Society, you agree to the standards for membership and to uphold the four values of the National Honor Society and Columbia chapter, which are to participate and demonstrate leadership in the areas of ***scholarship, service, leadership, and character.***
